Summary of key findings This provision meets requirements
<p>Through discussion, the childminder demonstrates a good understanding of the requirements for children's learning and development. The childminder also describes how she will adapt her teaching to effectively meet the developmental next steps for children of various ages and stages. She is able to explain how she plans her curriculum and what she wants children to learn.</p> <p>The childminder plans to track children's progress regularly. She understands the importance of working in partnership with parents to ensure there is consistency in the care and education between the home and setting. For example, the childminder intends to involve parents by sharing learning journeys each term along with children's individual developmental next steps that will be updated regularly. The childminder also explains she works closely with other settings and schools that are local to her.</p> <p>The childminder discusses her expectations for children's behaviour and conduct while they are at her home. She talks about how she would share her house rules with the children, so they understand what is expected of them.</p> <p>The childminder has a good safeguarding knowledge and is confident to follow her procedures for reporting any concerns she could have about children to the relevant agencies. The childminder has a good understanding of her responsibilities for reporting any allegations against herself, or a person living or working at the setting, to the local authority. The childminder discusses the signs of abuse and understands how wider safeguarding issues can impact children's safety.</p>

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early year's children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its



impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
